54.1 POLICY

- 1. It is the policy of the Office to allow the Charleston County Facilities Department to maintain our building in a safe, sanitary, and aesthetic manner.
- 2. The Charleston County Facilities Department conducts preventative maintenance on the Coroner's Office building located at 4000 Salt Pointe Pkwy, North Charleston, and coordinates contractors/vendors to the building when repairs, enhancements, adjustments, or cleaning are necessary to either the building or any of its equipment, instruments or appliances.
- 3. The heating/ventilation/air conditioning units, plumbing system, and electrical system shall be scheduled for routine inspection in accordance with the Charleston County Facilities Department.
- 4. Additionally, Facilities personnel oversee the cleaning contractor which is a bonded company. The cleaning contractor sends a person every business day to clean the Coroner's facility.
- 5. The Forensic Services Supervisor shall maintain documents showing the maintenance of any equipment or instruments regarding the morgue, autopsy suite, or evidence spaces.
- 6. The Administrator or designee shall coordinate with Facilities regarding repairs or maintenance situations.
